Mid-Year NEC Board Meeting February 24, 2024


Membership has increased by 15,000 from where we were last year. Investments are good. We received a clean audit. The total number of active units since August 2023 is 7,436. Forty-four charters were canceled. The Morris Field Unit 380 Charter from North Carolina was canceled. There have been 16 new charters and eight reinstated charters in our national organization since August 2023.
