A Quilt of Valor[®] (QOV) is a quality, handmade quilt that is machine or hand quilted. It is awarded to a Service Member or Veteran who has been touched by war. The Quilt says unequivocally, "Thank you for your service and sacrifice in serving our nation."

To use the term Quilt of Valor, Quilts of Valor or QOV, the quilt must be a specific size, must have a label with required information, it must be awarded (it is not a gift) and it must be recorded. Not a quilter? Please consider submitting someone for the award.

ASYMCA Operation Kid Comfort helps military children cope during deployments by providing loving, handcrafted quilts and pillowcases with custom photo-transfers. They help children handle the stress and loneliness that comes with being separated from a parent for a long period of time.

The ASYMCA sends 9 pictures of a military child with their deploying parent and the child's favorite colors and things they like. Volunteers find fabric the child would like and put it all together. The quilts are mailed back, and the kids have daddy/mommy with them all the time. Volunteers can work with participating locations across the U.S.
