HELPFUL MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Applications: Units may obtain membership applications from their department headquarters or download from the national website. Completed membership applications, along with payment of department and national dues, are sent by the unit to department headquarters. **The signature of the Post Officer should be on every application of those applying for membership in the ALA, including the 'Eligible-thru' Legion member's ID number.** The only exception to this is if the member is a female veteran and eligible in her own right, the Auxiliary unit officer can sign off on the application. The Post Officer verifies only eligibility and confirms the 'eligible-thru' ID number of the applicant, not acceptability of the applicant into the unit.

New Members: The following is taken directly from the ALA National Standing Rules: A new member joining the American Legion Auxiliary prior to the annual National Convention must pay full current annual dues to be eligible for full membership rights, privileges, and benefits. A new member joining after the National Convention may be given by the Unit full membership rights, privileges, and benefits from the date the dues are received through December 31 of the following year. ALAMIS Tip: When entering new members in to ALAMIS, members must have an effective date OF or AFTER September 1st of the current membership year in order for the member to be billed and joined for the upcoming membership year. Example, a member with a join date of August 15, 2021 will be joined and billed for the 2021 membership year; a member with a join date of September 1, 2021 will be joined and billed for the 2022 membership year.

Payment: Although the notices are emailed or mailed by National Headquarters, the unit member may pay dues directly to the person receiving dues at the unit – either in person or by mail, via credit card on the national organization website, www.ALForVeterans.org, or by calling the Membership Division at National Headquarters at **317.569.4570**. Members who choose to pay their dues on-line or over the phone will receive a receipt and have the ability to print their membership card. National Headquarters will mail a current year membership card to any member who renews or joins online.

Prompt Processing of Dues: Prompt processing of dues at the unit and department level is extremely important; National Headquarters must receive dues well before the dates listed in the Renewal Notice Mailing Schedule to prevent mailing unneeded notices. However, because delays do occur, it is of equal importance for unit and department leaders to educate their members that some may receive a renewal notice although their dues have been paid. In such cases, please inform them to disregard the notice. Members who have paid their dues to the unit but have not been passed on to the Department in a timely manner will not be eligible for any benefit and privileges until their dues are paid at the Department, and in turn National HQ. National dues are \$18.00 for Seniors and \$2.50 for Juniors, the balance of the \$13.00 or \$8.50 is used to support the Department.

Primary Purpose: The American Legion Auxiliary was formed to aid the American Legion in carrying out the great program of peacetime service to American to which The American Legion is dedicated. All of the Auxiliary's activities are designed to promote the work of The American Legion and to help the Legion reach its objectives. Auxiliary programs were created to aid, educate and provide financial support for veterans and their families; the organization focuses on helping to create a better society, particularly for the nation's future citizens - our children and young people.

ALAMIS is the database that contains all our membership information and is used by units and departments to manage members, units, and leadership information. Units are only allowed to designate up to two users for login access. This cost is \$10/year per login. This is collected through the department and transmitted to the NHQ. The department headquarters authorizes who has access. Units must contact their department with the name of the member who should have access to ALA MIS along with the member's email address. Units with access can update: new members, member information, edit/update unit leaders. They can also perform searches on member data and view many reports that can be downloaded into excel and used for mail merge to keep in contact with members.
