

Children and Youth Reporting

A. Most Outstanding Unit Children & Youth Program

- Award: Department Citation Certificate [1st, 2nd, 3rd]
- Guidelines: Narrative not to exceed 1000 words. Include specific examples of how your Unit worked the Children & Youth Program, including supporting military children and the Star-Spangled Kids Program. [may include pictures, news articles, news releases, etc.]

B. Star Spangled Kids

- Award: Department Citation Certificate [1st, 2nd, 3rd]
- Guidelines: Information included in your Unit report. Educating children about the US Constitution, Declaration of Independence, National Anthem, Pledge of Allegiance, and/or National Symbols [any or all] from the aspect of patriotism and Americanism.

C. Youth Hero

- Award: Youth Hero Medal and Citation
- Guidelines: Presented to: Youth under 18 years of age who have performed heroic acts of physical valor; membership in the American Legion Family is not required.
- Complete Good Deed Award and Nomination Form and mail to Department Secretary, who certifies, and mails to National Headquarters [do not mail directly to National]

D. Good Deed

- Award: Citation
- Guidelines: [Same as Youth Hero] who have performed specific good deeds and are a good example of community service in action.
