# CALL FOR THE 101<sup>ST</sup> ANNUAL DEPARTMENT CONVENTION

The 100<sup>st</sup> Annual Convention of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of North Carolina, will be held June 9-11, 2022, in Raleigh, NC. The Sessions will be in Ballrooms 4&5. Opening Session will be at 7:00 pm on Thursday, June 9, 2022.

The Department Executive Committee will meet Thursday, June 9, 2022 at 3:00 pm in Ballrooms 4&5. All members of the Executive Committee, Department Officers, including District Presidents, Chairman of Standing Committees, and Past Department Presidents) are urged to attend. The meeting will be open to all Auxiliary members. Only members of the Executive Committee will have a voice or vote.

# **PURPOSE**

- A. Receiving annual reports from Department Officers and Chairman.
- B. Electing Delegates and Alternate Delegates to the National Convention in Milwaukee.
- C. Electing and installing Department Officers for the ensuing year.
- D. Approving the budget for the ensuing year.
- E. Transacting such business as may properly be presented.

# **REPRESENTATION**

Each Unit with a membership of at least 10 Senior members shall be entitled to one Delegate and one Alternate Delegate. For each fifty (50) members, or portion thereof, whose current Department and National dues have been paid and received by the Department Treasurer 30 days prior to the meeting of the Department Convention (May 10), each Unit shall be entitled to two additional Delegates and Alternate Delegates. Department Officers, Standing Committee Chairmen and Past Department Presidents are Delegates-at-Large from their respective Units, and their vote is to be cast with the Unit vote.

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The number of Unit Delegates and Alternates to the Department Convention is as follows:

10-25 members	1 Delegate and 1 Alternate plus any Delegates-at-Large
26-75 members	3 Delegates and 3 Alternates plus any Delegates-at-Large
76-125 members	5 Delegates and 5 Alternates plus any Delegates-at-Large
126-175 members	7 Delegates and 7 Alternates plus any Delegates-at-Large
176-225 members	9 Delegates and 9 Alternates plus any Delegates-at-Large
226-275 members	11 Delegates and 11 Alternates plus any Delegates-at-Large

#### TROPHIES AND AWARDS

All poppy, written histories and scrapbook contest entries are to be taken to tables outside of Ballrooms 4&5 between 3:00 and 5:30pm Thursday afternoon and between 8:00 and 9:00am Friday morning. All entries must be checked in by 9:00am Friday. All entries will be judged on Friday. Each Department Officer or Chairman is responsible for securing judges and for providing the same with criteria for judging. Judging should not be done during the hours of the business sessions. All entries are to be picked up by 12 noon on Saturday. Neither the Department nor the Convention Committee will be responsible for returning them to the Units. All winning entries to be judged on the National level should be picked up by the respective Committee Chairman by Saturday noon. All senior poppy entries must have the member's name, unit name, unit number and category on the entry. Junior entries were judged at the Junior Department Meeting.

#### DEPARTMENT OFFICERS AND COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

Please observe the time scheduled on the program for your report and be prepared to present it at any time. You are to be seated at the front of the room in the vicinity of the microphone. Those reporting will be allowed 3 minutes. The exception is Veteran's Affairs and Rehabilitation and Membership that will be allowed 10 minutes. Reports for the Electronic Year Book must be mailed or emailed to Department Headquarters by May 30 and a copy sent to the Department Historian, Betsy Phillips, 211 Elm St. Asheboro, NC 27203. PLEASE DO NOT give them to the Department Secretary at Convention. In a few weeks, the Department Officers and Committee Chairmen will receive information concerning awards. It will include a report form for listing award recipients and a form for ordering ribbons and certificates. Please read the information carefully and follow the instructions so that the awards part of the Convention will go smoothly. Awards are to be presented when you give your report. Those programs that are to be judged at Convention must give the Department Secretary a list of all awards when the judging has been completed.

#### DEPARTMENT CITATION

The following requirements must be met by the close of the Department books for Convention, May 10th, 2022 in order to receive the Department Citation:

- General Fund Donation: \$25.00
- Equal last year's membership
- VA&R contribution
- Poppy order or donation
- Treasurer's Bond: \$7.00

In addition, a Membership Certificate will be awarded to those Units that reach 100% or above of their 2021-2022 Membership Goal by May 10, 2022.
